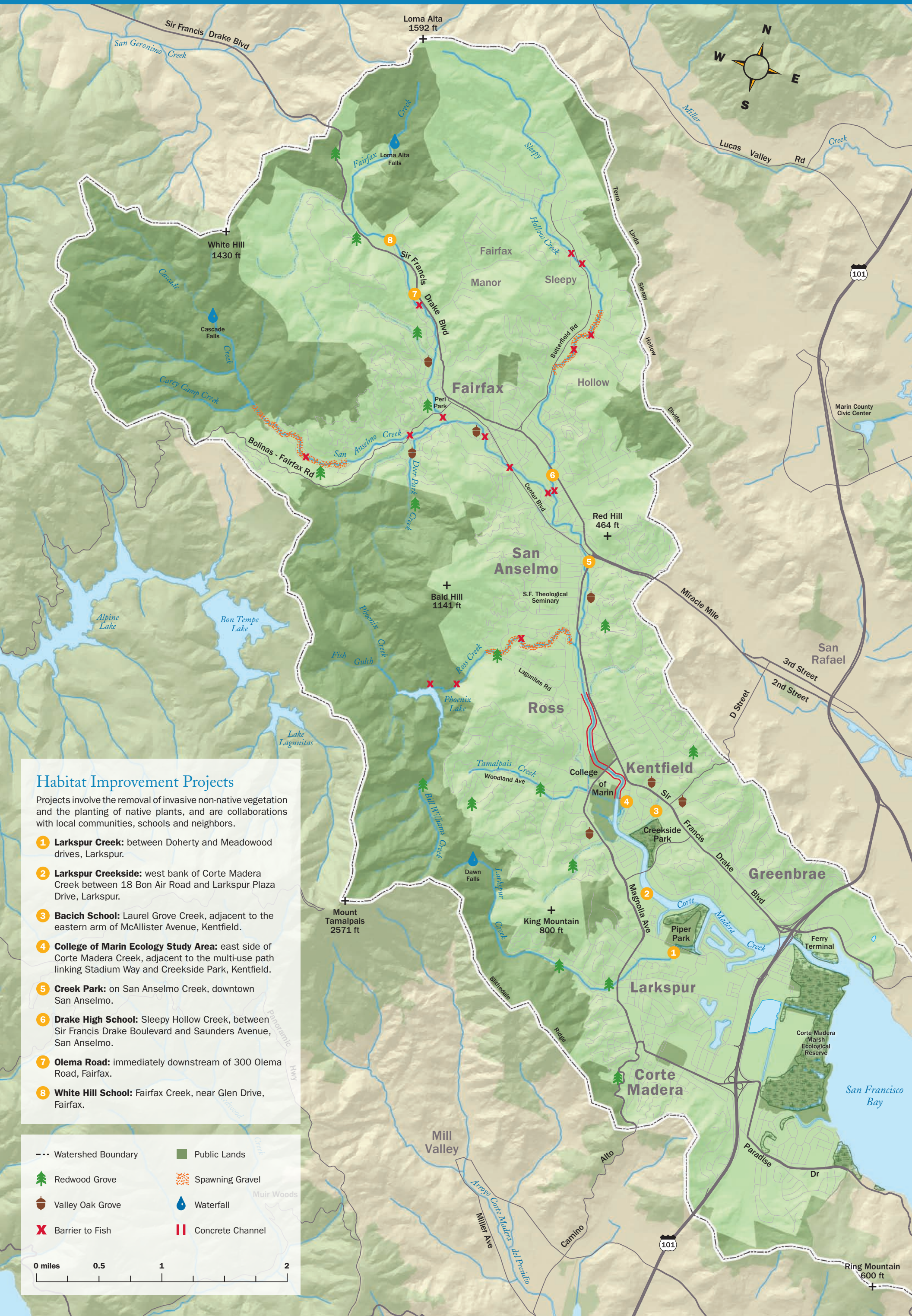


Corte Madera Creek Watershed



Habitat Improvement Projects

Projects involve the removal of invasive non-native vegetation and the planting of native plants, and are collaborations with local communities, schools and neighbors.

- 1 **Larkspur Creek:** between Doherty and Meadowood drives, Larkspur.
- 2 **Larkspur Creekside:** west bank of Corte Madera Creek between 18 Bon Air Road and Larkspur Plaza Drive, Larkspur.
- 3 **Bacich School:** Laurel Grove Creek, adjacent to the eastern arm of McAllister Avenue, Kentfield.
- 4 **College of Marin Ecology Study Area:** east side of Corte Madera Creek, adjacent to the multi-use path linking Stadium Way and Creekside Park, Kentfield.
- 5 **Creek Park:** on San Anselmo Creek, downtown San Anselmo.
- 6 **Drake High School:** Sleepy Hollow Creek, between Sir Francis Drake Boulevard and Saunders Avenue, San Anselmo.
- 7 **Olema Road:** immediately downstream of 300 Olema Road, Fairfax.
- 8 **White Hill School:** Fairfax Creek, near Glen Drive, Fairfax.
